The IRLC will host a winter hike at 10 a.m.

The guided hike and snowshoe rental are free to the public. This is the perfect opportunity for individuals who want to try snowshoeing for the first time.

Local Ecologist Julie Covey will be on hand to lead the hike. Covey has also worked with The Central and Western New York Chapter of The Nature Conservancy, Thousand Islands Land Trust and Ontario Bays Initiative over the past 20 years, leading field trips, creating interpretive materials, and teaching about the flora and fauna to be found in Northern New York.

During the hike, she will discuss nature's wonders in the wintertime. The hike will be approximately 2 miles of easy walking.

Participants are invited to warm up after the hike with hot cocoa and a cheerful fire.
