

The Grand Lake Reserve presents a spectacular landscape, rich with biological diversity, rugged geography and beautiful scenery.

Located between Butterflied and Grass Lakes and including more than 5 miles of shoreline. the Grand lake Reserve offers a model of how conserved lands can provide public access for recreation and educational benefit while still preserving a unique and valuable

The Grand Lake Reserve was created in 2003 through a generous gift of more than 800 acres from local summer resident Henry Carse, a pioneering environmentalist and civic leader.

Since then additional acquisitions have expanded the reserve to over 1,000 acres and over 7 miles of public access trails.
